## **Food Policies & Community Initiatives**

- <u>UglyFruitAndVeg</u>: Program that promotes reducing food waste and sustainable food practices.
- Bill Emerson Good Samaritan Food Donation Act: Encourages food donors to donate by protecting them from liability
- <u>Assembly Bill (AB) 2178</u>: Allows Limited Service Charitable Feeding Operations to qualify for and obtain a registration instead of an Environmental Health permit.
- <u>SB1383 Organics Recycling:</u> Requires Monterey County residents to collect food scraps and requires businesses to recover edible food by donating it to local food banks or non-profit organizations.
- Monterey County Food Systems Collaborative: Food professionals and enthusiasts of all kinds.
  Healthcare leaders. Chefs. City planners. Compost enthusiasts. Farmers market founders.
  Educators. Equity advocates. Everyone and anyone invested in extending nutritious and locally grown produce to all is welcome to join the conversation.
- <u>Project FoodBox:</u> Grocery delivery program that provides fresh, nutritious food to patients with medical needs
- <u>Double Up Food Bucks</u>: Providing a 50 percent discount on California-grown produce for CalFresh shoppers from participating grocery stor<u>Fresh Rx</u>: Partnership between health care providers and farmers markets where doctors "prescribe" fresh fruits and vegetables to patients and direct them to a farmers market where they can receive \$25-\$35 worth of fresh produce.

• Everyone's Harvest Market Match: CalFresh/EBT shoppers' - \$1 for \$1 match for fresh fruits and vegetables. \$30 on card & \$30 match = \$60 daily max
